- Open to undergraduate students

 - Legal Studies majors with 3.0 GPA
 - Students who took Eco-Justice (CJS 103) with 3.0 GPA
- Completion of 24 university credit hours prior to departure
- Good academic and disciplinary standing
- Completion of application with essay and faculty recommendation. Additional information found in application.

Program Description:

- Students in Legal Studies will have the opportunity to partner with students who have taken CJS103 Eco-Justice on a trip to Guatemala to explore environmental crime and justice issues within the country.
- During this program, students will have the opportunity to meet with faculty & students from Rafael Landívar University who are interested in environmental crime/justice legal issues.
- We will visit cultural and environmental sites in/around Guatemala City.
- You will also serve as hosts when students and faculty from Rafael Landívar University in the Fall 2020 term.

Academics:
