- Jeremy T. reported that he is focusing on the advocacy regarding the desires and needs of non represented staff. He is researching ways to develop a network to get similar representation at the table.

## Statement of Subject: Special Committee on Campus Culture

- Connie C. reported that the team is planning 3 events, the first one is on November 3rd at 3:00 p.m. with Chancellor Gillman who will give his support followed by Dr. Douglas Haynes, Police Chief Liz Griffin, and professors. Phong L. reported that Chief Griffin will be giving updates regarding safety on campus. Karissa S. reported that Douglas Haynes will be talking about the Black Thriving Initiative. John. B. reported that Judy Wu will be presenting on the historical context about anti black racism and social injustice. A website will be coming for these events.
- John B. added that the newsletter will be featuring staff members who are Campus Culture Champions and how they are improving campus culture. Connie C. reported that the whole intent is to get staff to be more involved, to empower everyone else, and get others involved in their efforts. We are open to suggestions and ideas. John B. added that we are trying to engage,

empower, and motivate staff.

## **Statement of Subject: Web Communications**

## Statement of Subject: Human Resources, Employee Engagement and Wellness

- Pamela J. reported that we have 7,000 students living on campus and undergrads at 45% capacity and grads 75% capacity. Phase 2 testing was completed at move-in and we had 6 positives and 55 students in quarantine. Phase 3 testing started this week. Testing is going well and quick with a less invasive nasal swab. Lou G. added that we are trying to get this right and do what is best for the student.
- On the staff side there are about 2,200 staff who come to campus on average on a regular basis.
- Webinars on working remotely with 7 topics are available online. 200 staff attended the Mental Resilience webinar.
- We launched Career Tracks and are working with staff on reconsiderations.
- Dyan H. is working on the welcome back kits. She is working with the building managers to disseminate them across campus in November. Inside the kits will be 2 masks and 1 branded UCI mask, lanyard, coaster, sanitizer, and lunch bag.
- Approval for post COVID child care program. The ER backup care program will serve faculty, staff, and grad students and provide subsidized care to children and elders up to 10 uses per year per person. It's designed to provide support when things happen. They have an internal database and schedule 24/7 rate is \$6 per hour, 1 child is \$15 per day, and a family of up to 10 kids costs \$25 per day. More information to come.
- We are creating a centralized family resource support web page to provide elder and childcare support.
- We got approval to host a Staff Appreciation Week on October 12-16, 2020. Thank you to Connie C. and Joani H.! Enterprise wide, we will be launching a Bright People Brilliant Solutions campaign including a virtual bulletin board of appreciation to show your colleagues, staff, leaders, etc. Staff will be able to submit and post their appreciations and call people out.
- On Tuesday, October 13th at 1:00 p.m., Connie C. is leading the Awards. Wednesday, October 14th the Town Hall will happen with the Chancellor.
- The gifts will be distributed when we get back in person. The new lapel pins are specific to UCI and the gemstones have been redone with the actual year imprinted on it.
- The Barclay Theatre is doing a jazz concert for those on site.
- We created a leadership tool kit with a step-by-step guide on what leaders can do each day to appreciate your staff and includes: how to give virtual recognition; sample letters; and questions supervisors should be asking on how people would like to be recognized.
