- 2) An undergraduate may register for the Credit/No Credit option in no more than the smaller of 12 semester credit hours or 20% of the total number of hours of upper-division course work taken at The University of Texas at Dallas. Courses in a student's major which are designated as Credit/No Credit are not included in this limit. Courses taken on a Credit/No Credit basis will not be used in determining a student's GPA.
- 3) Credit/No Credit may NOT be used for Program prerequisites, core or major and related courses (unless so mandated in the catalog.)
- 4) Interdisciplinary Studies Courses (IS) **MAY NOT** be taken Credit/No Credit **unless** they are being taken as free electives – **NOT** to satisfy any part of the six (6) hours Interdisciplinary Studies course requirement.
- 5) A graduate student may not elect to take on a Pass/Fail basis core courses and their prerequisites required for the degree, or electives in the student's major area, or more than 20% of the hours for any master's degree at the University of Texas at Dallas (excluding casebook, internship, practicum, independent study, research, reading, thesis or dissertation requirements). Only Pass/Fail grades are given for independent study, research, and reading, and for thesis or dissertation.
